

## TSCA - Declaration

The Toxic Substance Control Act (TSCA) is a U. S. federal regulation that enforces a variety of requirements and restrictions on the presence of certain chemical substances in U. S. commerce. Under TSCA, the U. S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), among other things, regulates substances in products imported into or manufactured in the U. S. evaluates substances for restrictions, and imposes penalties for non-compliance. On January 06, 2021, the EPA issued mandatory regulations against the PBT chemicals listed below. This regulation is legally effective since March 2021.


- Decabromdiphenylether (DecaBDE), CAS 1163-19-5
- Phenol, isopropyliert, Phosphat 3:1 (PIP 3:1), CAS 68937-41-7
- 2,4,6-Tris (1,1-dimethylethyl) phenol (2,4,6-TTBP), CAS 732-26-3
- Hexachlorbutadien (HCBD), CAS 87-68-3
- Pentachlorbezolthiol (PCTP), CAS 133-49-3
